Fall Fundraising Campaign Underway

The sixth annual direct mail fundraising campaign continues, with a goal of \$50,000 to enhance TESH services and opportunities for adults and children with developmental and mental disabilities. TESH Board Members are contacting donors and making visits through the end of the year, sharing information about tax incentives available to Idaho individual and corporate donors.



It's Not Too Late to Make a Contribution to TESH

Charitable donations, when made to a qualifying charity like TESH (501c3) result in a deduction on individual and corporate Federal and State tax returns. In addition, donations to TESH, Inc. qualify the donor to receive a youth and rehabilitation facility state tax credit, even if they do not itemize. The credit is limited to the smaller of the following: 50% of the amount contributed, 20% of Idaho Tax due, or \$100 (\$200 if married filing a joint return.) Donations by check, cash, or credit card, or donations of goods or services, are appreciated and help fulfill the TESH mission in the community.
